**BEAUTIFUL ONE DAY
QUARRIES THE NEXT**

There are three large quarry proposals north of Raymond Terrace. The first is Stoneridge Quarry, a new quarry occupying 139 hectares of the Wallaroo State Forest on the northern side of Italia Road. The Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is currently on exhibition awaiting submissions from the community. Boral has lodged a scoping report to extend the life of Seaham Quarry by 30 years, running 24/7 and almost double its maximum output. The Eagleton mine project is also being revived. A conservative amount of quarry trucks will be 1000 daily.

If allowed to continue, these projects will destroy our locality and community as we know it.
